**CALL TO ORDER**

The Meeting was called to order at 11: 11 hours.

Prior to the commencement of the Meeting, National Anthem was sang followed by a prayer given by Bishop Shern Kaumba, Chairperson, Church Representative.

**OPENING REMARKS**

The Assistant Public Relations Manager welcomed everyone present. She informed members that they were invited to that Meeting for the purpose of the 2026 budget consultation which was by law, a requirement that such Meetings were to be held once every year to enable the stakeholders and Community submit projects they intended to be undertaken in various areas.

She further reminded members that, it was also in line with the Presidential pronouncements regarding decentralization, which meant among other things that budgeting was to start from bottom upwards or from the Community to National level. She encouraged members that decision was to be made by both Management and the Community.

The Assistant Public Relations Manager further said that, the Integrated Development Plan was formulated by the people of Mazabuka through their representations. It was a five years plan to guide on projects among the construction of Dams, Roads and many others.

She guided that the submission was to be in two parts, which were for Expenditure and income parts. The Assistant Public Relations Manager also indicated that, the Ward Development Committee members were should be in front in identification of Revenue sources.

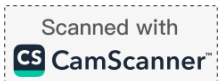
Thereafter, the Assistant Public Relations Manager requested for the submission of proposed local projects to be undertaken in Mazabuka Central Constituency which was as follows;

**BC/01/09/25:**

**KAONGA WARD**

The Kaonga Ward representative presented the Expenditure part on projects to be undertaken during the 2026 budgets as listed below;

1. Construction of a Primary School between Riverview and Chilala, behind the Motel with;
  - i. 2 staff houses
  - ii. Ablution block
  
2. Construction of Market shelter at Kaonga market with;
  - i. Ablution block

- 3. Installation of street lights along major roads
- 4. Rehabilitation of Kaonga Primary and Namulonga School

The representative added that the income Would be the levy on Farmers who would be off loading their merchandise on the open space to be paved at Town Center Market.
